Vendor Information and Guidelines

2010 Booth Fees until August 15

- ➔ Regular booth fees are \$50 without electricity or \$55 with electricity (20amps) for a 12' by 12' space.
- ➔ Food Booths are \$100 for a 12' by 12' space payable in advance with registration form.
- ➔ Non-profit organizations that wish to sell non-food items will be charged \$25 for a booth.

Former Vendor Fees until August 15 (Vendors who paid booth fees in 2009)

- ➔ Regular booth fees for 2009 festival vendors are \$40 or \$45 with electricity for a 12' by 12' space.
- ➔ Food booth fees are \$85.00 without electricity and \$90 with electricity for a 12' by 12' space.
- ➔ Non-profit organization booth fees for non-food items are \$20.00 payable in advance.

► After August 15, food booth fees will increase to \$125. Art and craft booth fees will increase to \$65.00.

- Please rent as many 12' by 12' spaces as you will use. Indicate on the registration form if you are using a tent or trailer. Trailer space is limited. Application forms must be submitted and fees are payable in advance by check, money order, or PayPal.
- **Arts and crafts vendors are encouraged to sell original crafts only and have hand crafted items. Other merchandise must be approved by the Tumbling Waters Vendor Committee. Unapproved items cannot be sold. Pictures of items should be submitted with the application if you are a new vendor.**
- Franchised and chain food establishments cannot participate. Any type non-alcoholic drinks may be sold.
- Regular booth fees apply for commercial exhibits. The Board of Tumbling Waters maintains the right to prohibit items.
- Booths for educational exhibits and demonstrations are free if no food or merchandise is offered for sale. A registration form must be submitted, and approved.
- Participants are responsible for any equipment needed such as tables, extension cords, tents, etc.
- Operating hours are Saturday, 10 am to 6 pm and Sunday, 12:30 to 5:30 pm. **The festival will be held rain or shine.**
- **Set up time is Friday, Sept.17 from 12:00 until 7:00 pm and Saturday 8am until 9:30am.** Sign in at the registration table near the covered bridge to get booth and parking locations. Maps to the park are on the web site.
- The park will be secured at night with night guards on duty. Booths will be secure Friday and Saturday nights.
- **No pets, camping, or overnight stays are allowed in the park.** (Jackson County Park and Recreation Dept. Regulation)
- A \$10 reward is offered to vendors who recruit a new vendor for the festival. Applications may be copied and obtained online. Rewards will be available at the registration table, Sept 17 – 18.
- Tumbling Waters Board may limit the number of food and craft vendors. Former vendors will be given preference. Food booths will be limited and duplication of food products will be controlled.
- The festival is a two-day event. Please indicate if you can participate for only one day.
